Abstract

Robotic process automation (RPA) technology is one of the hottest topics about digital transformation of all enterprises. It is the next frontier for businesses looking to streamline processes, increase productivity and ultimately improve the bottom-line. Robotic Process Automation allows anyone today to configure computer software, or a “robot” to emulate and integrate the actions of a human interacting within digital systems to execute a business process. In contrast to other traditional IT solutions, RPA allows organizations to automate at a fraction of the cost and time previously encountered. Robots are here to stay. The faster you harvest their potential, the faster you create a competitive edge for your business.

In this seminar, we will introduce what actually the Robotic Process Automation is? How is RPA different from other enterprise automation tools? What are the business benefits of RPA? And most importantly, how it influence the traditional audit processes?
